- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within [4-5] weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [4-5] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. Please note that some of our programs have only one annual academic assessment (in June), and thus, in such cases, incoming students coming for the first semester will only receive their Transcript of Records in July.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

Students enrolled as of the date of termination will be permitted to complete their studies.
